Junior Kindergarten

Planning has begun in preparation for our Junior Kindergarten program which

To register your child, you will need the following:

-Birth Certificate

-**Manitoba Health Number** and any important medical information for your child

-**Custody or Guardianship Documents** (if applicable)

-Proof of Residence or

Confirmation of Permanent Canadian Residence (if applicable)

Volunteer Record Check Day

In order to volunteer at Gretna Elementary School, the required record checks must be completed. Volunteering could include helping in your child's classroom or accompanying them on a class field trip.

One of the checks is a Criminal Record Check and the other is the Vulnerable Sector Check. A Volunteer Check application day has been set up for Tuesday, April 9, 2024 from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. at the Altona Police office for residents who live in the RCMP jurisdiction. The Criminal Record Check is normally done at Morden's RCMP office, so this is a great way to get your checks done without having to drive to Morden.

The applicants will need to bring two acceptable pieces of government issued ID (one being photo ID), as well as a volunteer letter which will be supplied by Gretna School once requested. The originals must be presented at the time of application.

Results for the CR/VS applications will be mailed out once completed.

All applicants must be over the age of 18. Please call the school if you have any questions.
